Company Members:

For Ballet Company members, summer classes are intended for the girls to maintain and enhance the level of technique achieved during the year. All Ballet Company members are required to attend **20** hours over the course of the summer.

Attire:

Ballet: Leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers, pink pointe shoes, ballet bun.

Contemporary: Appropriate dancewear, dance pants or shorts with leotard or dance top. Students may be bare footed or wear footundeez.

Tap: Appropriate dancewear, dance pants or shorts with leotard or dance top. Black oxford tap shoes.

Hip-Hop: Appropriate dancewear or loose-fitting pants and top. Flat sole sneakers are preferred. These should not be shoes that have been worn on the street. Please have a separate pair of shoes for in-studio use only.

- Evening make-up classes are available.
